1 **BY GARY HAYES:**

2 I WANT TO WELCOME EVERYBODY. I'M GARY HAYES.
3 TONIGHT IF YOU'VE GOT SOMETHING TO SAY, WHEN YOU
4 HAVE SOMETHING TO SAY, PLEASE SPEAK CLEARLY, STATE
5 YOUR NAME AFTER YOU'VE BEEN RECOGNIZED, AND WE'LL
6 FOLLOW UP FROM THERE. I APPRECIATE EVERYBODY
7 COMING. WE'VE GOT A GOOD AGENDA TONIGHT. AT THIS
8 TIME, I WANT TO TURN IT OVER TO RON NESBITT. HE'S
9 GOING TO TALK TO US ABOUT SOME OF THE PROJECTS'
10 STATUS.

11 **BY RON NESBITT:**

12 GOOD EVENING. I'M GLAD EVERYONE COULD MAKE IT
13 HERE TONIGHT. BEFORE I GET INTO GIVING YOU AN
14 UPDATE ON WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING WITH THE PROJECTS AS
15 FAR AS THE YEAR'S CONCERNED AS WELL AS WHAT WE HOPE
16 TO BE ABLE TO DO THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR, I WOULD LIKE
17 TO INTRODUCE SOMEONE TO YOU, OUR NEW D.E. I SAY,
18 NEW; NEW TO YOU. HE'S BEEN WITH US NOW FOR A LITTLE
19 OVER A YEAR. HIS NAME IS COLONEL PETER MUELLER, WHO
20 IS DISTRICT ENGINEER. I WAS ABLE TO PERSUADE HIM TO
21 COME UP TONIGHT EVEN THOUGH HE'S BEEN TRYING TO COME
22 UP TO OUR LAST TWO R.A.B. MEETINGS, BUT HIS SCHEDULE
23 JUST WOULDN'T ALLOW IT. BUT, NONETHELESS, HE'S HERE
24 TONIGHT. COLONEL MUELLER, IF YOU WOULD SAY A FEW
25 WORDS.

26 **BY COLONEL MUELLER:**

27 I'D JUST LIKE TO SAY A FEW WORDS, AND REALLY
28 I'VE WANTED TO COME UP HERE FOR QUITE SOME TIME AND
29 REALLY APPRECIATE THE OPPORTUNITY TO BE HERE
30 TONIGHT. I JUST WANT TO SAY THANKS TO ALL THE
31 MEMBERS OF THE R.A.B. IT'S A VOLUNTEER THING YOU'RE
32 DOING, AND I'D ALSO LIKE TO THANK THE OTHER PEOPLE
33 THAT ARE HERE TONIGHT BECAUSE IT IS AN IMPORTANT
34 THING FOR US AS REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FEDERAL
35 GOVERNMENT AND CORPS, IS TO BE ABLE TO BE HERE TO
36 GET FEEDBACK FROM EVERYBODY THAT'S HERE BOTH ON THE
37 BOARD AND FROM THE COMMUNITY. I UNDERSTAND THE
38 IMPORTANCE OF WHAT THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND THE
39 ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS IS TRYING TO DO HERE FOR THE
40 OLD CAMP CROFT. I UNDERSTAND THE IMPORTANCE TO THE
41 COMMUNITY, AND WE ARE DEFINITELY HERE TO DO
42 EVERYTHING WE CAN FOR YOU. THE ONLY OTHER THING I
43 CAN SAY IS THAT WE'RE ALWAYS FRUSTRATED WITH THE
44 LEVEL OF FUNDING THAT WE GET FOR THINGS LIKE THIS,
45 AND THIS YEAR WILL BE NO EXCEPTION AS THE PRESIDENT
46 IS MAKING HARD DECISIONS ABOUT WHAT GETS FUNDED AND
47 WHAT DOESN'T, AS WE'RE EXPERIENCING WAR ON TERRORISM
48 RIGHT NOW. SO, FUNDING IS ALWAYS AN ISSUE FOR US AS

1 WELL AS FOR THE FOLKS THAT ARE LOOKING FOR
2 PROGRESS HERE. AND, AGAIN, I JUST WANT TO THANK YOU
3 FOR EVERYTHING THAT YOU'RE DOING, ESPECIALLY FOR THE
4 FEEDBACK WE GET FROM MEETINGS LIKE THIS, AND I
5 APPRECIATE YOUR TIME TONIGHT.

6 **BY MR. NESBITT:**

7 THANK YOU, SIR. TWO THINGS I'D LIKE TO BRING
8 TO YOUR ATTENTION. SINCE JANUARY OR FEBRUARY OF
9 THIS YEAR, WE'VE BEEN ABLE TO COMPLETE ONE PARCEL OF
10 PROPERTY, OR I SHOULD SAY ONE AREA, THAT WE'VE BEEN
11 WORKING ON FOR SOME TIME. MOST OF YOU KNOW IT AS
12 THE LANDFILL SITE THAT WE'VE BEEN WORKING ON FOR
13 SOME TIME. THAT IS NOW COMPLETED. BASED UPON
14 FUNDING THIS COMING FISCAL YEAR, OUR PROJECTION FOR
15 WORK TO BE DONE IN THIS AREA IS ACTUALLY NOT VERY
16 GOOD. IN FACT, THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS THAT WE HAVE FOR
17 THIS AREA DOES NOT AT PRESENT PROJECT ANY MAJOR WORK
18 TAKING PLACE AT THE CAMP CROFT AREA AT ALL THIS
19 YEAR. NOW, WHAT DOES THAT REALLY MEAN? IT MEANS
20 BASED UPON CURRENT BUDGETING, WE HAVE NO FUNDS TO DO
21 ANY WORK. NOW, WE WILL BE ENGAGED IN PROVIDING SOME
22 TRAINING, SOME EDUCATIONAL BROCHURES, ADDITIONAL
23 EDUCATION FOR THE COMMUNITY, TALKING WITH THE
24 NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AT THE STATE PARK AREA, AND
25 DISCUSSING WAYS OF TRYING TO CONTINUE TO GET THE
26 WORD OUT TO THE PUBLIC ABOUT THE SAFETY AND HOW TO
27 RESPOND SHOULD THEY COME ACROSS SOMETHING IN THE
28 PARK AREA OR IN THE AREAS AROUND IT. THAT WILL
29 CONTINUE TO BE DONE, AND SHOULD FUNDS SHOULD COME
30 OUR WAY DURING THE COURSE OF THE YEAR, BE IT AT THE
31 END OF THE FISCAL YEAR OR SOMETIME DURING THE
32 PERIOD, THAT IS SUBSTANTIAL ENOUGH THAT WE CAN GO
33 BACK TO THE SUBDIVISION AND CONTINUE TO REMOVE THE
34 SMALL QUANTITY OF ORDNANCE THAT WE KNOW EXISTS IN
35 THAT AREA THAT WE'VE GOT GUARDED AND PROTECTED; THE
36 GOLF COURSE AREA THAT HAS ORDNANCE LOCATED IN SOME
37 AREAS THAT WE'VE IDENTIFIED, THAT WE'VE STILL YET TO
38 CLEAR; THESE ARE THE PRIORITIES THAT WE ARE LOOKING
39 AT IN TERMS OF IF FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FOR US AT
40 THAT GIVEN TIME. I CAN SAY TO YOU, SUCH AS WHAT THE
41 COLONEL JUST MENTIONED, WITH THE SITUATION AS IT IS
42 IN TERMS OF MONEY BEING AVAILABLE, MONEY BEING USED
43 FOR OTHER PURPOSES WITHIN THE COUNTRY RIGHT NOW, I'M
44 NOT SAYING THAT THE PRIORITY AS FAR AS WHAT WE ARE
45 DOING IN FUNDS HAS LESSENERED; HOWEVER, THE TOUGH
46 DECISIONS ARE BEING MADE, AND THE MONIES ARE BEING
47 USED WHERE THEY FEEL IS MOST NEEDED AT PRESENT.
48 ~~HOPEFULLY, THAT WILL CHANGE IN THE VERY NEAR FUTURE.~~

1 WE ARE EXPECTED TO DO BETTER NEXT YEAR AS FAR AS
2 FUNDING LEVELS ARE CONCERNED, AND SHOULD THAT HAPPEN
3 THEN WE HOPE TO BE ABLE TO PROCEED WITH THE AREAS
4 THAT I MENTIONED AS THE PRIORITY SITES RIGHT NOW, TO
5 GET THOSE THINGS TAKEN CARE OF. OKAY. THERE WERE A
6 NUMBER OF QUESTIONS THAT WERE RAISED AT OUR LAST
7 MEETING, AND WHAT I WILL DO IS SUMMARIZE THESE
8 QUESTIONS WITH ANSWERS THAT WE HAVE PROVIDED. A
9 QUESTION WAS RAISED REGARDING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST
10 OF SEVERAL MEMBERS SERVING ON THE BOARD. ALL
11 MEMBERS SERVE ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS AS EVERYONE IS
12 AWARE, AND DO NOT RECEIVE ANY COMPENSATION IN ANY
13 WAY, SHAPE OR FORM. THE INDIVIDUAL THAT POSED THE
14 QUESTION HAS GENERALIZED THE SOUTH CAROLINA LAW, AND
15 IN ORDER TO FULLY EVALUATE THE VALIDITY OF THE
16 CONCERN, THE CITATION AS TO THE PRESIDING LAW IN
17 SECTION REFERENCE IS REQUIRED. IN OTHER WORDS, WE
18 HAVE TO HAVE IT IN WRITING SO IT CAN BE FULLY
19 EVALUATED AND DECIDED UPON WHETHER OR NOT THERE IS,
20 IN FACT, A CONFLICT OF INTEREST, WHICH BASED ON WHAT
21 WE'RE DOING, THERE ISN'T ONE. A QUESTION RAISED
22 REGARDING AN AREA IN PACOLET WHERE THE OLD NURSING
23 HOME IS, PLAYGROUND OR GYM THAT IS HIGHLY
24 CONTAMINATED WITH -- HIGHLY CONTAMINATED. AN AREA
25 IN THE PACOLET AREA WAS EVALUATED BASED ON MUSTARD
26 GAS BURIAL. NO EVIDENCE WAS FOUND, AND IN ORDER FOR
27 THE CORPS TO FULLY EVALUATE THE QUESTION, WE NEED IN
28 WRITING THE NAME OF THE NURSING HOME, THE PARK AREA,
29 AND ANY SUSPECTED CONTAMINANTS THAT MIGHT BE IN THAT
30 AREA AS WELL SO IT CAN BE EVALUATED PROPERLY.
31 QUESTIONS REGARDING THE CONTAMINATED WELLS IN THE
32 GLENDALE ROAD AREA, WE STILL HAVE NO REAL EVIDENCE
33 EXACTLY WHERE IT WAS LOCATED. WE'RE STILL UNSURE.
34 THE PREVIOUS CONCERNS REGARDING WELL WATER WERE
35 FOLLOWED UP WITH TESTING BY THE DEPARTMENT OF DHEC.
36 NO CONCERNS WERE NOTED.

37 FOR A QUESTION REGARDING GERMAN P.O.W. GRAVES,
38 NOT WITHIN PRIVY OF THIS PROGRAM, WHICH WE HAVE SAID
39 BEFORE. MORE APPROPRIATE IDENTITY -- IN FACT, I
40 GUESS, MORE APPROPRIATELY, THE QUESTION SHOULD GO TO
41 THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE SINCE WE HAVE
42 NOTHING IN WRITING ABOUT THAT HERE. OKAY. THEY
43 WILL BE MORE IN A POSITION TO DEAL WITH THAT
44 QUESTION THAN WE ARE BECAUSE THAT'S NOT A PART OF
45 WHAT WE ARE HERE TO DEAL WITH.

46 THE QUESTION REGARDING THE BURIAL TANKS AND
47 TRANSFORMERS, YOU NEED TO CLARIFY THE VEHICLE TANKS
48 OR USTS. EITHER WAY, UNDER THE DIRECT PERVIEW OF

1 THIS PROGRAM, WE ARE UNCERTAIN WHAT THE QUESTION
2 REALLY ENTAILS, WHETHER IT IS NOT A PART OF THIS
3 PROGRAM OR NOT. WE NEED MORE SPECIFIC GUIDANCE,
4 MORE SPECIFIC DETAILS ABOUT THE QUESTION ITSELF:
5 WHAT TRANSFORMERS, WHERE IT'S LOCATED, AND SO ON.

6 REGARDING THE R.A.B. TOURS, NEWSLETTERS, AND
7 BROCHURES, THESE DOCUMENTS ARE UPDATED AND PLACED IN
8 AREAS TO BE EVALUATED AND/OR REVIEWED BY EVERYONE IN
9 THE DIFFERENT LOCATIONS, SPECIFICALLY IN THE
10 LIBRARIES, AND SO ON. THE TOUR OF DUTY FOR ANYONE
11 ON THE BOARD HAS BEEN PRESCRIBED, AND, IN FACT, WE
12 HAVE TALKED ABOUT THEM BEFORE. AND, IN FACT, WE'RE
13 IN THE PROCESS, IF I'M NOT MISTAKEN, OF REQUESTING
14 NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS THAT ARE WANTING OR WOULD LIKE
15 TO SERVE ON THE BOARD FOR THE NEXT TERM BASED UPON
16 INDIVIDUALS THAT ARE COMING UP FOR LEAVING THEIR
17 POSITION ON THE BOARD. SO THE OPPORTUNITY FOR
18 ANYONE TO PARTICIPATE AS A PART OF THE BOARD IS
19 AVAILABLE TO ANY AND EVERYONE. YOU DO GO THROUGH AN
20 EVALUATION PROCESS JUST LIKE THEY DID, AND WE WILL
21 HAVE FORMS FOR THAT PURPOSE THIS AFTERNOON, OF WHICH
22 YOU CAN MAKE CERTAIN THAT ZAPATA GETS SO THAT THEY
23 CAN BE EVALUATED AND GO THROUGH THE CORRECT PROCESS.

24 NOW, THESE ARE THE QUESTIONS THAT WERE RAISED
25 AT THE LAST MEETING, ADDRESSED AT THE LAST MEETING
26 AS WELL, BUT WE FELT THAT THEY NEEDED TO BE CLEARER,
27 MORE CLEARLY IDENTIFIED AND DISCUSSED, OR AT LEAST
28 ANSWERED, THE BEST THAT WE COULD BASED UPON THE
29 INFORMATION WE HAD. HOPEFULLY, I'VE CLARIFIED THAT
30 SOMEWHAT. WE'LL MOVE ON, AND, MR. CHAIR, -- OH, I'M
31 SORRY; SUZY, YOU'RE NEXT.

32 **BY MS. MCKINNEY:**

33 MY NAME IS SUZY MCKINNEY WITH ZAPATA
34 ENGINEERING, AND AS EVERYONE IS AWARE, WE PROVIDE
35 THE SUPPORT FOR THE RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD.
36 BEFORE WE GO TOO FAR DOWN THE ROAD, I WANT TO MAKE
37 SURE THAT ALL THE R.A.B. MEMBERS HAVE SIGNED IN ON
38 THE SIGN-IN SHEET THIS EVENING. I ALSO WANT TO
39 INTRODUCE TWO INDIVIDUALS FROM HUNTSVILLE: BILL
40 STEPHENSON, THE PROJECT MANAGER, AND DAN HUEY,
41 (PHONETIC) THE TECHNICAL MANAGER, U.S. ARMY
42 ENGINEERING SUPPORT CENTER IN HUNTSVILLE. SO, THEY
43 ARE ALSO DIRECTLY INVOLVED WITH THE PROJECT.

44 AS FAR AS THE RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD AND
45 OUR TERMS, WE'VE COME TO CLOSURE ON ANOTHER TWO
46 YEARS. SO THE PROCESS AS DEFINED IN THE BYLAWS IS
47 FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS INTERESTED TO COMPLETE A
48 FORM. WE HAVE SEVERAL OF THEM TONIGHT AVAILABLE.

1 WE HAVE FORMS IN THE LIBRARY. THEY ARE DUE BACK TO
2 ME BY THE END OF NOVEMBER FOR CONSIDERATION TO SERVE
3 ON THE NEXT TERM FOR THE RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD.

4 WE HAVE PLENTY OF COPIES. IF YOU KNOW OF FOLKS WHO
5 ARE NOT HERE TONIGHT THAT WOULD LIKE TO PARTICIPATE
6 OR HAVE EXPRESSED AN INTEREST, PLEASE FEEL FREE TO
7 TAKE SEVERAL COPIES WITH YOU AND HAND THOSE OUT. IF
8 INDIVIDUALS TALK TO YOU ALL AND WOULD LIKE COPIES,
9 THEY CAN CALL ME TOLL FREE, 888-242-8862, AND WE'LL
10 GET COPIES OUT OF THESE INTEREST FORMS. AS RON
11 MENTIONED, ONCE THOSE FORMS ARE RECEIVED, WE WILL GO
12 THROUGH AN EVALUATION AND SELECTION PROCESS AS WE'VE
13 DONE IN THE PAST WHERE WE IDENTIFY A MINIMUM OF
14 THREE INDIVIDUALS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COMMUNITY TO
15 EVALUATE THE INFORMATION THAT'S PRESENTED AND MAKE

16 RECOMMENDATIONS ON INDIVIDUALS WHO WILL BEST
17 REPRESENT THE COMMUNITY AND THE INTERESTS AND THE
18 NEEDS TO SERVE ON THE BOARD.

19 THE NEXT R.A.B. MEETING WILL BE A TRANSITION
20 BETWEEN THE OLD BOARD AND THE NEW BOARD, AND AT THE
21 RATE OUR MEETINGS ARE FLOWING EVERY THREE TO FOUR
22 MONTHS AND WITH THE HOLIDAYS COMING UP UNLESS WE
23 KNOW OTHERWISE, I'M GUESSING THAT WILL BE
24 JANUARY/FEBRUARY TIME FRAME. BUT IN THAT INTERIM,
25 WE WILL GO THROUGH THE SELECTION PROCESS. THE
26 RECOMMENDATION WILL BE FORWARDED FROM THAT SELECTION
27 PANEL THROUGH US TO THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR FINAL
28 APPROVAL BY THE COLONEL AT THE DISTRICT LEVEL FOR
29 THE NEW R.A.B. SO, AGAIN, THESE FORMS ARE HERE
30 TONIGHT. WE HAVE COPIES IN THE LIBRARY. I
31 ENCOURAGE YOU ALL TO TAKE THOSE AND DISTRIBUTE THEM.

32 I BELIEVE THAT WAS ALL I HAD FOR THIS EVENING. YOU
33 ALSO NOTICE THAT WE HAVE UPDATED A FACT SHEET. WE
34 HAVE SOME OF THOSE HERE TONIGHT. FEEL FREE TO TAKE
35 THOSE WITH YOU. WE'VE LEFT COPIES IN THE LIBRARY AS
36 WELL. WE DO HAVE A NICE CHRONOLOGY IN A PACKET THAT
37 WE'VE PUT TOGETHER, AND I HAVE THOSE THAT WE WILL
38 HAVE AVAILABLE AT THE NEXT MEETING. THEY ARE ALSO
39 AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITE. I DON'T KNOW IF ANY OF
40 YOU HAVE HAD A CHANCE TO JUMP ON AND GO THROUGH THE
41 WEBSITE. IT'S WWW.CAMPCROFT.COM., A NICE PACKAGE OF
42 INFORMATION WITH THE CHRONOLOGY OF THE PROJECTS AND
43 THE STATUS OF THE PROJECTS. THE MEETING TRANSCRIPTS
44 ARE POSTED ON THERE. WE HAVE SOME G.I.S. MAPS AND
45 ARE POPULATING THAT WITH ADDITIONAL DATA FROM THE
46 PAST EVALUATIONS. SO, AGAIN, ANOTHER OPPORTUNITY TO
47 KEEP APPRISED OF THE PROJECTS AND TO GET SOME
48 GENERAL INFORMATION. AND WITH THAT, I BELIEVE,

1 WE'VE COVERED OLD BUSINESS AS FAR AS WHAT RON HAD.
2 I DON'T KNOW IF GARY WANTED TO SEE IF WE HAVE ANY
3 ADDITIONAL OLD BUSINESS FROM THE BOARD TO DISCUSS.

4 **BY MR. HAYES:**

5 NOBODY HAS SAID ANYTHING ABOUT OLD BUSINESS.
6 DOES ANYBODY ON THE BOARD HAVE ANY OTHER OLD
7 BUSINESS? (NEGATIVE RESPONSE) I GUESS NOW WE CAN
8 ADDRESS NEW BUSINESS. I TALKED WITH SUZY RIGHT
9 BEFORE THE MEETING, AND NO ONE HERE HAS SENT ANY
10 LETTERS IN WANTING TO DISCUSS ANY NEW BUSINESS AT
11 THIS MEETING. I WANT TO MAKE SOMETHING VERY CLEAR.

12 AT THE LAST MEETING, I KEPT REPEATING TO EVERYBODY
13 THAT IF THEY WANTED NEW BUSINESS TO BE BROUGHT UP AT
14 THIS MEETING, THEY HAD TO STATE IT IN WRITING TO
15 EITHER SUZY OR RON, AND EVERYTHING WOULD BE PUT ON
16 THE AGENDA, AND WE'D BE GLAD TO HAVE IT BROUGHT UP
17 AS NEW BUSINESS AT THIS MEETING. WELL, NO ONE HAS
18 WRITTEN TO HAVE NEW BUSINESS AT THIS MEETING, BUT WE
19 WILL TAKE BRIEF STATEMENTS FROM ANYBODY AT THIS
20 TIME, AND THERE WILL NOT BE ANY LONG DISCUSSION
21 ABOUT ANY SUBJECTS AT THIS TIME. BUT IF SOMEBODY
22 WANTS TO MAKE A BRIEF STATEMENT, AND IT HAS TO BE
23 BRIEF. IF IT'S NOT BRIEF, I WILL CUT YOU OFF.
24 THERE WILL NOT BE ANY DISCUSSIONS, BUT YOU CAN STATE
25 YOUR NEW BUSINESS FOR THE NEXT MEETING SO IT WILL BE
26 ON THE RECORD FOR THE NEXT MEETING. DOES ANYBODY
27 WANT TO MAKE A BRIEF STATEMENT AT THIS TIME? IS
28 THERE ANY -- HAROLD, DO YOU WANT TO MAKE A BRIEF
29 STATEMENT?

30 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

31 RON, ON THAT DEAL YOU SAID ABOUT HAVING TO BE
32 IN WRITING, IF YOU WOULD GO BACK ON THE RECORDS,
33 YOU'LL FIND THAT THE AREA IN PACOLET HAS BEEN
34 WRITTEN UP A LONG TIME AGO.

35 **BY MR. HAYES:**

36 OKAY, HAROLD, DO YOU WANT THIS BROUGHT UP AT
37 THE NEXT MEETING?

38 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

39 WELL, HE SAYS HE DON'T KNOW WHERE IT'S AT.

41 COPIES, AND I'LL MAKE SURE THAT YOU GUYS ALL GET A
42 HOLD OF A COPY. ALSO, NOW, I'M TRUTHFUL. I'M
43 TELLING YOU EXACTLY WHAT I'M GOING TO DO. I WAS
44 CALLED BY WASHINGTON, D.C., TO MAKE A PRESENTATION
45 ON FINDING OUT WHAT HAPPENED TO ALL OF THIS
46 AMMUNITION 'CAUSE I HAD ALREADY TALKED TO TALKED TO
47 ---

48 **BY MR. HAYES:**

1 OKAY. SO, YOU HAVE TWO NEW SUBJECTS YOU WANT
2 TO BE BROUGHT UP AT THE NEXT MEETING?

3 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

4 BEG YOUR PARDON?

5 **BY MR. HAYES:**

6 YOU HAVE TWO NEW SUBJECTS YOU WANT BROUGHT UP
7 AT THE NEXT MEETING?

8 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

9 NO, I THINK THESE SHOULD BE ADDRESSED NOW WITH
10 ALL THE LIVE AMMUNITION THAT WAS TAKEN UP AND PUT IN
11 A PEACH SHED.

12 **BY MR. HAYES:**

13 WELL, HAROLD, I JUST WENT OVER THAT. WE'RE NOT
14 GOING TO HAVE ANY DISCUSSION.

15 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

16 I FIGURED AS MUCH. ALSO, FOR YOUR INFORMATION,
17 I WOULD LIKE TO HAVE A COPY OF THE MINUTES OF THIS
18 MEETING. THANK YOU.

19 **BY MR. HAYES:**

20 WE STATED AT THIS LAST MEETING TO BE FAIR TO
21 EVERYBODY, AND WE CAN LOOK BACK ON THE MINUTES, AND
22 I MADE SURE THAT I REPEATED IT OVER THREE TIMES,
23 PLUS WE DISCUSSED IT WITH DIFFERENT PEOPLE AFTER THE
24 MEETING, LAST MEETING. SO, THIS IS SOMETHING THAT
25 KEEPS OUR MEETING FOCUSED AND TO THE POINT. SO,
26 NOW, I THINK MR. OSBORNE HAS STATED HE WANTS TO
27 PRESENT SOME PAPERS TO EITHER RON OR SUZY ABOUT THE
28 PROPERTY IN PACOLET AND ALSO ABOUT SOME MUNITIONS.
29 SO, YOU WILL SUPPLY ---

30 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

31 I'LL GET THEM A COPY.

32 **BY MR. HAYES:**

33 OKAY. SO, THIS WILL BE PUT ON THE AGENDA FOR
34 THE NEXT MEETING.

35 **BY MR. OSBORNE:**

36 ONE OTHER THING, IF I COULD INTERJECT REAL
37 FAST. IF WE COULD GET THE MEETING DATES -- I GOT
38 MINE IN THE MAIL SATURDAY. HOW CAN I GET UP AN
39 AGENDA OR TELL WHAT I WANT ON THE AGENDA IF I ONLY
40 GET THEM SATURDAY?

41 **BY MR. HAYES:**

42 OKAY. WE'LL TRY TO MAYBE GET SOME NOTICES OUT
43 A LITTLE AHEAD OF TIME.

44 **BY MS. MCKINNEY:**

45 THEY WERE MAILED TWO WEEKS AGO. SO, APPARENTLY
46 THERE WAS A PROBLEM.

47 **BY MR. HAYES:**

48 ~~THERE MUST HAVE BEEN A HOLDUP IN THE MAIL OR~~

1 SOMETHING. I DIDN'T GET MINE UNTIL ABOUT THE SAME
2 TIME EITHER, BUT, YOU KNOW, I WAS ABLE TO MAKE IT
3 HERE. THE NEXT MEETING IS GOING TO BE AFTER THE
4 FIRST OF THE YEAR. SO, FROM NOW UNTIL AFTER THE
5 FIRST OF THE YEAR THERE'S PLENTY OF TIME TO PUT
6 THINGS IN WRITING IF THERE'S SUBJECTS THAT PEOPLE
7 WANT BROUGHT UP, AND I WANT TO MAKE SURE EVERYBODY
8 UNDERSTANDS. IS THERE ANYBODY THAT DOESN'T

10 THERE SOMETHING YOU WANTED TO SAY?

11 **BY MS. MCKINNEY:**

12 I WANTED TO FOLLOW UP WITH MR. OSBORNE. HE DID
13 CALL ME REGARDING SOME CONCERNS ABOUT MUNITIONS THAT
14 HAD BEEN FOUND ON THE GOLF COURSE AND PUT IN TRUCKS
15 AND THEN HAULED OFF-SITE. I REMINDED HIM THAT HE
16 NEEDED TO CALL THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT. I JUST
17 WANT TO GO ON RECORD THAT I CONTACTED LIEUTENANT
18 DIAZ ON TWO OCCASIONS TO FOLLOW UP TO BOTH MR.
19 OSBORNE AND MR. ZIMMERMAN'S TELEPHONE CALLS ABOUT
20 THEIR CONCERNS OF ITEMS THAT HAD BEEN FOUND AND/OR
21 STORED, ACCORDING TO THOSE INDIVIDUALS, IMPROPERLY.
22 NOW, MR. RENNA IS HERE TONIGHT. HE SUPPORTS THE
23 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, AND I KNOW HE HAS BEEN IN
24 RESPONSE -- AND RESPONDED WITH THE SHERIFF'S
25 DEPARTMENT TO SOME OF THOSE. RICK, IF YOU WOULD
26 LIKE TO STATE, JUST SO WE HAVE A PICTURE OF WHAT THE
27 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HAS RESPONDED TO WITH THE WORK
28 THAT'S BEING DONE AT THE GOLF COURSE.

29 **BY MR. RENNA:**

30 ON TWO OCCASIONS WHEN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE GOT
31 A CALL THAT WORK CREWS PUTTING NEW HOLES IN THE GOLF
32 COURSE FOUND ORDNANCE, I RESPONDED WITH LIEUTENANT
33 DIAZ TO THE GOLF COURSE. THE FIRST OCCASION WAS, I
34 BELIEVE, IF I REMEMBER CORRECTLY, AN 81 MILLIMETER
35 PRACTICE ROUND, AND THEN THE SECOND OCCASION, WE
36 FOUND ANOTHER PRACTICE ROUND. SO, AT THAT POINT IN
37 TIME, WE TOOK OUT METAL DETECTORS AND COVERED THE
38 AREAS THAT THEY WERE GOING TO EXCAVATE AND THE

40 TIME, WE DISCOVERED ANOTHER PRACTICE ROUND AND A
41 PRACTICE AND A TANK MINE. WE COVERED A LARGE BIT OF
42 AREA WITH THE METAL DETECTORS AND DID NOT DISCOVER
43 ANYTHING ELSE. WE DISCUSSED THE SITUATION WITH THE
44 GOLF COURSE PERSONNEL AND THE CONTRACTORS ON THE
45 SCENE, AND THEY ARE VERY CONCERNED WITH THE
46 ORDNANCE, AND THEY SAID THAT THEY WOULD CALL US AT
47 ANY TIME THAT THEY FIND ANY ITEMS. WE DID NOT
48 RECEIVE ANY MORE PHONE CALLS FROM THEM, AND WE'RE

1 PRETTY SURE THAT THE AREAS THAT WE COVERED, THERE
2 WERE NO OTHER ORDNANCE LOCATED THERE.

3 **BY MR. HAYES:**

4 AND SO, NO ORDNANCE WAS FOUND?

5 **BY MR. RENNA:**

6 NO LIVE ORDINANCE WAS FOUND ON THE GOLF COURSE.
7 THREE PRACTICE ROUNDS AND A PRACTICE AND A TANK
8 MINE WERE FOUND, AND WE DISPOSED OF THOSE.

9 **BY MR. NESBITT:**

10 BILL, DO YOU HAVE ANYTHING TO ADD TO THAT, OR
11 KNOW OF ANYTHING?

12 **BY MR. STEPHENSON:**

13 I JUST WAS COPY FURNISHED ON THE, I GUESS,
14 RECORD OF THE CONVERSATIONS THAT HAD HAPPENED, THE
15 RESPONSE THAT WAS TAKEN, AND THAT WAS THE SAME
16 INFORMATION I RECEIVED CONCERNING THOSE ISSUES. AS
17 FAR AS I'VE HEARD, THERE'S BEEN NO OTHER REPORTS OF
18 ANY ORDNANCE MADE. I'M THINKING THE POLICE
19 DEPARTMENT SINCE THEY'RE THE CLOSEST PERSON ARE THE
20 ONES WHO ARE GOING TO HEAR IT VERSUS SOMEBODY WHO'S
21 IN HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA, 400 MILES AWAY. THERE HAVE
22 BEEN NO OTHER REPORTS THAT I'M KNOWLEDGEABLE OF.

23 **BY MR. HAYES:**

24 THANK YOU. ALL RIGHT. THAT SHOULD DO IT. HAS
25 ANYBODY ELSE GOT ANY BRIEF STATEMENT THEY WANT TO
26 BRING UP ABOUT NEW BUSINESS FOR THE NEXT MEETING
27 AFTER THE FIRST OF THE YEAR? LET ME REPEAT AGAIN,
28 IF THERE IS ANY NEW BUSINESS AFTER THIS MEETING THAT
29 NEEDS TO BE BROUGHT UP AT THE NEXT MEETING, IT NEEDS
30 TO BE PUT INTO WRITING AND MAILED TO EITHER SUZY OR
31 RON. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THEIR ADDRESS, YOU CAN GET
32 THEIR ADDRESS AFTER THE MEETING. IS THAT UNDERSTOOD
33 FROM EVERYBODY? OKAY. I WANT TO THANK EVERYBODY FOR
34 COMING OUT TONIGHT. LIKE I SAID, THE NEXT MEETING
35 IS GOING TO BE AFTER THE HOLIDAYS AFTER THE FIRST OF
36 THE YEAR. SUZY HAS FORMS FOR THE COMMUNITY FORMS
37 FOR THE NEXT R.A.B. BOARD THAT WILL BROUGHT UP AT
38 THE NEXT MEETING. DO YOU HAVE A DEADLINE TO HAVE
39 THOSE IN, SUZY?

40 **BY MS. MCKINNEY:**

41 THE END OF NOVEMBER. I THINK IT'S NOVEMBER
42 29TH ON THE FORM.

43 **BY MR. HAYES:**

44 OKAY. THEY HAVE TO BE IN BY NOVEMBER 29TH.
45 HAS ANYBODY GOT ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT THAT? OKAY. I
46 WANT TO THANK EVERYBODY FOR COMING OUT. DOES
47 ANYBODY HAVE A MOTION WE ADJOURN?

48 **BY MR. SMITH:**

1 I MOVE WE ADJOURN.

2 **BY MR. POWELL:**

3 I SECOND.

4 **BY MR. HAYES:**

5 THE MOTION HAS BEEN PASSED AND SECONDED, AND
6 SO, WE CALL THIS MEETING ADJOURNED. (7:30 P.M.)
