

PROJECT COMMENTS: CESAC comments: Project consists of at least 12 impact areas. Site is being systematically studied through two EE/CAs with data from two Archive Search Reports.

CEMVR comments: On November 4, 1940, the War Department announced that a new training center would be located in Spartanburg County, South Carolina. Camp Croft Infantry Replacement Training Center (IRTC) was officially activated on January 10, 1941, with housing for 20,000 trainees and support personnel. It served the next four-plus years as one of the Army's principal IRTCs and approximately one-quarter of a million soldiers were trained. Camp Croft was also a prisoner of war camp. The installation was declared surplus to the Army's needs in November, 1946, and excessed to the War Assets Administration in 1947.

DESCRIPTION: The gas chambers were located just northeast of the former cantonment area. The range fan lies entirely within site boundaries and does not overlap any other range fans.

COMMENTS: Historic maps indicate there were 3 gas chambers in this area during the WWII era known as Range 14. It is assumed CS was used in the chambers. The range fan is the immediate area surrounding the buildings. The fan does not go beyond site boundaries or overlap other range fans. A residential area is nearby. However, it is unlikely that residual CS is present after 50 years since site closure. The range received a RAC score of 3 due to the potential for riot control agents to exist there. Since this is unlikely, RAC 5 should be considered.



DESCRIPTION: The Grenade Court was located just east of the cantonment area and south of the gas chambers. The range fan lies within site boundaries and does not overlap with other range fans.

COMMENTS: This range is the location of a former WWII era grenade court, also known as Range 12. It is assumed that this range was a live grenade court and utilized Mk II fragmentation grenades. The range fan used is the standard range fan for a live grenade court as given in AR 750-10, January 1944. The range fan does not extend beyond site boundaries or overlap other range fans. The range received a RAC score of 2 due to the potential for hand grenades to exist there.

COMMENTS: Moving Target AT Range is the former Range 11 on Camp Croft, a moving target anti-tank range. Ordnance use on the range is believed to have included rifle grenades and 2.36 inch rockets. The range fan used is that of a standard moving target anti-tank range as given in AR 750-10, January 1944. The range fan overlaps other range fans and the right limit of the range fans extends beyond site boundaries. The range received a RAC score of 2 due to the potential for rifle grenades and 2.36 inch rockets to exist there.


